

Council Highlights

November 2018

The Finance Ministry has adopted the following policy:

All receipts and requests for reimbursement for expenses for church functions must be turned in within 60 days of the event. If the request has not been turned in after 120 days the amount requested for said reimbursement will be regarded as a donation on the church member's giving record.

Faith Formation Ministry – We are moving the Sunday school classrooms downstairs and returning the parent's chapel back to its former function as a regular chapel . The nursery will be available downstairs for parents to use and we are hoping to have a TV available for live streaming of the service. Sunday school will begin at 9:30 a.m. and dismiss at 10:00 a.m.

Search and Call Committee – Currently working on the Church Profile and the Senior Pastor Job Description has been approved by the Congregation.

Church Council 2019 – Current Council members were re-elected to their positions with the addition of Tom Thompson serving as President-Elect and Harry Kujath moving to the position of Communication Ministry Chair.

NOTE: Half of the Council members will serve for a one year term while the others will serve a two year term in order to maintain the rotation of members as indicated in the bylaws.

Budget – Three proposals were presented to the Congregation on Sunday, November 18. The third proposal was approved. (Budget proposals are located in the Church Council secretary's binder. Council secretary is Freda Maness.)

Fundraising – Several fundraising ideas were shared at the Congregational meeting. The Communications Ministry has been assigned to discuss and plan fundraising events. If you have suggestions for fundraising, please contact Harry Kujath or any Council member.
