The church council approved to hire a paid permanent Nursery Attendant on Sunday mornings who is not a member of Central Church. If you know of anyone who may be interested, see Patti Schmutzler, chair of Human Resources Ministry.

Carpet Replacement: At the recent church council meeting, there was discussion regarding the need to replace the aging carpet in the office, library and hallway areas as it is really showing the signs of having been there for many years. There is an estimated 3,500 square feet of carpet that needs to be replaced. No decision has been made on the new surface type, but preliminary estimates are in the range of \$20,000 – \$26,000 to replace it. As this would be an unbudgeted item for 2022, the Council wanted to make the congregation aware of this need. If anyone wants to contribute to defray the expense of the replacement, you can do so by getting it to the church office marked ‘Carpet Replacement’ or dropping it in the offering plate during Sunday service. Council will include this in budget discussions for 2023 that will begin this fall.

Festival of Sharing Kit for August – Missouri Family Food Box:

Place your items in the box marked Festival of Sharing in the narthex. Last year, 4,122 Missouri Family Food Boxes were requested; however, only 1,957 boxes were available to be shared. This box is in great demand. Please help by bringing the items below:

3 boxes macaroni & cheese

3 cans tuna

3 cans chicken (size of a tuna can)

1-pound pasta

1 can pasta sauce

1 jar peanut butter

3 different cans of vegetables (corn, peas, green beans
or carrots)

3 different cans of fruit (peaches, pears, fruit cocktail
or mandarin oranges)

Central Church will again be partnering with Second Christian Church for their Summer Lunch Program. Lunch will be offered from June 6 through August 19. You can help by donating money or items. Please place items in the basket marked Summer Lunch Program in the narthex. If you want to make a donation, give it to a member of the Mission and Outreach Ministry and we will get it to the ladies doing the program. They also need volunteers to help prepare the lunches. Here is a list of items needed: pudding cups; cookies; chips; fruit cups; snack cakes; Jell-O cups; brownies; fruit snacks; fresh fruit/veggies; condiment packets; bottled water; juices; Kool-Aid packets for water *(nothing with peanut butter or items with nuts)*.

The annual rummage sale is scheduled for Saturday, August 6th at 7:00am. We'll be setting up on Thursday, August 4th beginning at 10:00am, and Friday, August 5th at 8:00am. If you have some free time on those days, please come lend a hand. We'll also need help the day of the sale and we're asking all volunteers to be there at 6:30am. You may start dropping off your items in the gym on Monday, August 1st. Please do not bring TV's, computers, monitors, or printers.

Choir Meeting – On Wednesday, August 3, we will meet in the choir room at 7:00pm to discuss choir and special music. Anyone who is interested in singing or playing music, please come join us.

Dominoes will not meet on Wednesday, August 3. We'll resume the following Wednesday on August 10.
